




Wedding Favours Album

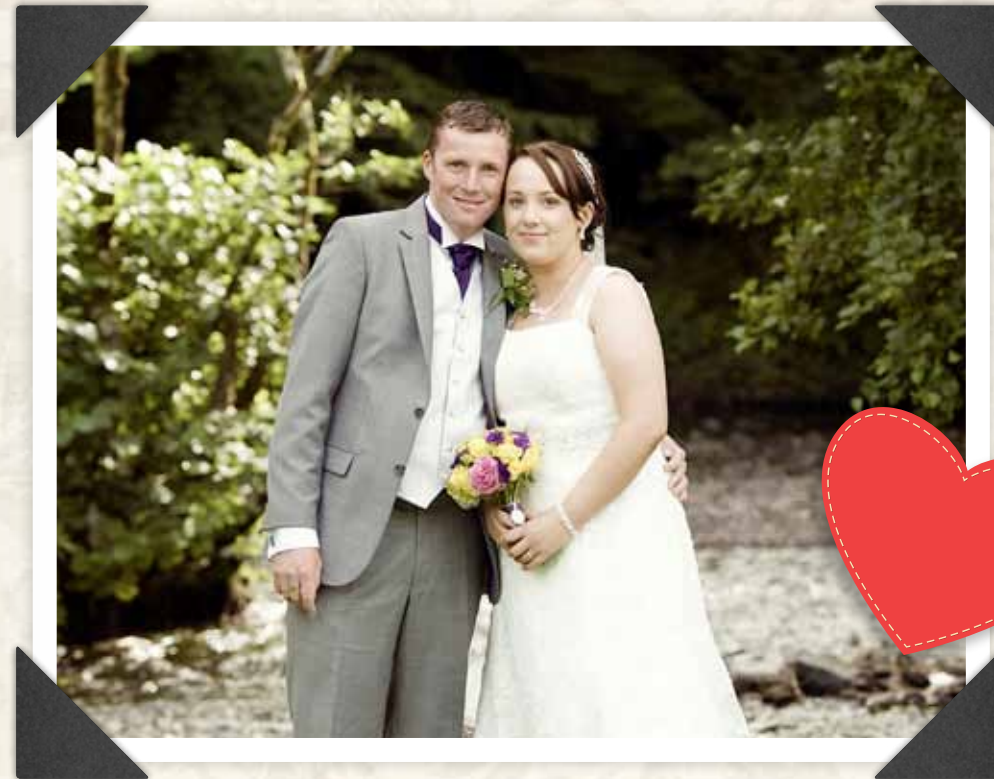




Sue & Owen, 7th June 2013
