#### **Teacher Overview - Week 1**

Day	Activity	Brief description	Cross - Curricular link (optional)
Monday	Funky Fruit	Spin a fruit-themed movement wheel and do the movement it lands on	<b>Art &amp; creativity:</b> Pupils design colourful fruit paintings or create a 'funky fruit dance'
Tuesday	Dance Dice	There are different movements for each number on the dice	<b>Maths:</b> Play a dice game activity (e.g. 'Pig')
Wednesday	Looseners	A variety of gentle movements for mobilising and warming up the body (all can be done from the classroom chair)	<b>Science:</b> Discuss muscles and joints and different <u>parts of the body</u> and why stretching is important. <b>English:</b> Spell out weekly spellings with their fingers in the air
Thursday	Huffers	A range of higher intensity movements for a more active break	<b>Science:</b> (Human Life) Heart & Pulse: Pupils carry out a <b>pulse experiment</b> measuring their pulse before and after different activities.
Friday	Pupil Voice, Pupil Choice	An opportunity for children to vote to re-do their favourite activity of the week, or try something new!	<b>English:</b> (Speaking and listening) Children explain their choice and why they liked that activity



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### **Teacher Overview - Week 2**

#### 3rd-6th class

Day	Activity	Brief description	Cross - Curricular link (optional)
Monday	Opposites Game	Children partner up and follow the movements on screen - each will do the opposite to each other, then switch	<b>English:</b> Opposite adjective lesson - create a list of adjectives, children come up with the opposite
Tuesday	Pencil Jumps	An activity where children move over their pencil in different ways	<b>Maths:</b> Count jumps, skip count or solve maths problems
Wednesday	Stretchers	A range of stretching movements that can be done from the classroom chair	<b>SPHE:</b> (Wellbeing) Link stretching to the benefits of <u>mindful movements</u>
Thursday	Active Alphabet	Each letter of the alphabet has a different movement to act out	<b>English:</b> Descriptive writing lesson on each image of the alphabet
Friday	Pupil Voice, Pupil Choice	An opportunity for children to vote to re-do their favourite activity of the week	<b>English:</b> (Speaking and listening) children explain their choice and why they liked that activity
