Role description	Due to the continued success of the Happy Heart Healthy Eating
	Award initiative, we wish to engage a contract dietitian for sessional
	work on this programme. Operating as an independent contractor, the
	individual will carry out catering audits in staff restaurants with the aim
	of enabling the restaurants to provide and promote healthy options to
	employees. During the onsite visit, he/she will also provide general
	advice and support to workplaces that are implementing a healthy
	eating programme.
	It is anticipated that the successful candidate will be required to work
	in primarily the Leinster area for approximately 2-3 days/month,
	although the location and frequency may vary. Note the majority of
	healthcare sites in Leinster are based in/near Dublin. Full training will
	be provided, in advance of work commencing and on an ongoing
	basis. It is expected that the individual would commit to at least one
	year with the Foundation, following completion of initial training.
