

# Resuscitation Quality Improvement® (RQI®)



## The What, Why and How of RQI

### WHAT

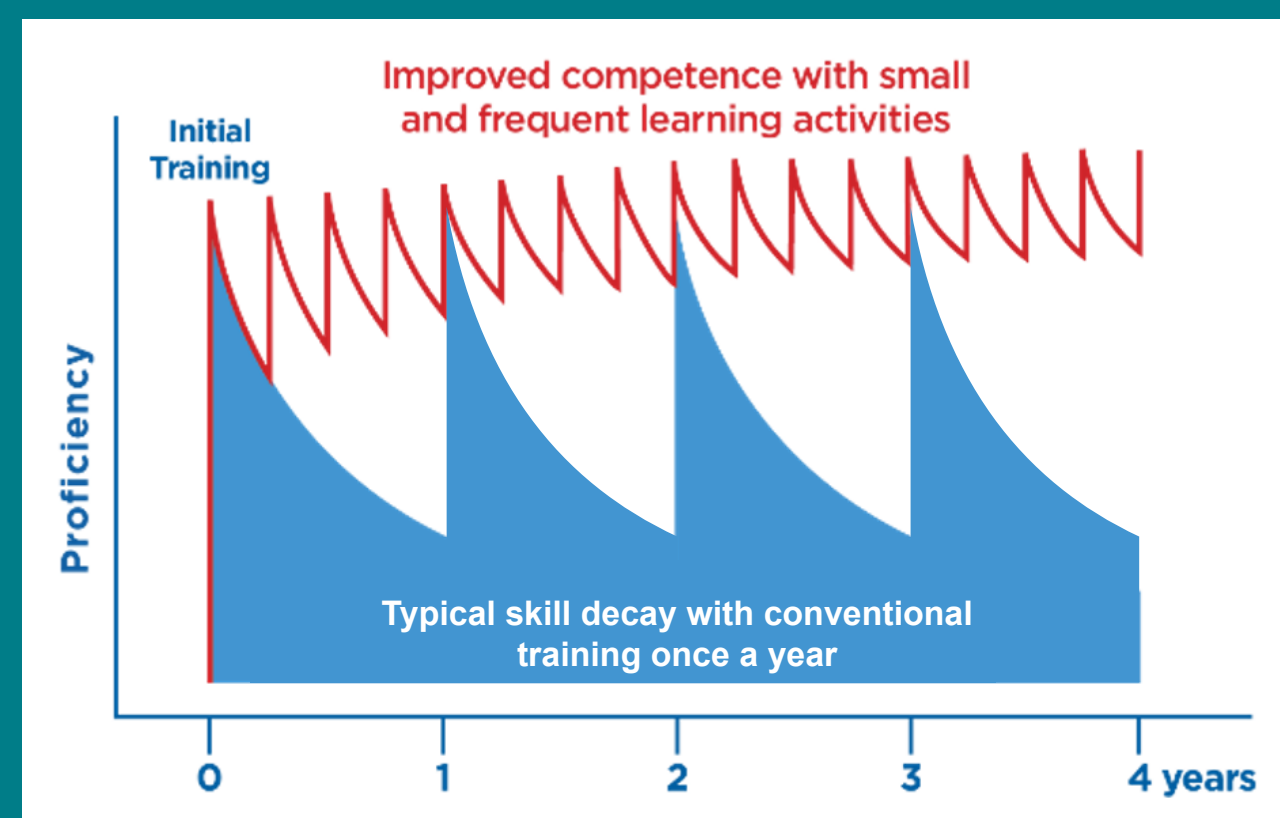
*The Resuscitation Quality Improvement programmes combine low-dose, high-frequency sessions, directive audiovisual skills feedback, and self-directed learning at the point of care.*

*Instead of attending in-person CPR courses infrequently, RQI learners verify competencies once per quarter to achieve and maintain skills mastery in high-quality CPR.*

### WHY

*Studies show that infrequent training is not optimal for achieving the mastery learning of high-quality CPR skills needed to save more lives. Skills decay occurs in as few as 3 months after training.*

*The perpetual curriculum of the RQI programmes replaces skills decay with verified competence and saves lives.*



### HOW

*You will receive an assignment for RQI.*

*Start by completing the programme entry assignment and then move to the perpetual curriculum, completed each quarter.*
