




Resuscitation Quality Improvement® (RQI®)



The What, Why and How of RQI

WHAT

The Resuscitation Quality Improvement programmes combine low-dose, high-frequency sessions, directive audiovisual skills feedback, and self-directed learning at the point of care.

Instead of attending in-person CPR courses infrequently, RQI learners verify competencies once per quarter to achieve and maintain skills mastery in high-quality CPR.

HOW

You will receive an assignment for RQI.

Start by completing the programme entry assignment and then move to the perpetual curriculum, completed each quarter.

WHY

Studies show that infrequent training is not optimal for achieving the mastery learning of high-quality CPR skills needed to save more lives. Skills decay occurs in as few as 3 months after training.

The perpetual curriculum of the RQI programmes replaces skills decay with verified competence and saves lives.
