

There are 18,000 heart patients and stroke survivors in County Kerry.

Help us protect services that can give them a better life.

Every **seven minutes** in Ireland a heart or stroke patient is discharged from hospital and returns home to what is often a bleak and uncertain future.

In County Kerry alone an estimated 18,000 people are affected by a cardiovascular condition.

Among stroke survivors there is a widespread sense of **abandonment** caused by a lack of community rehabilitation and support services.

The quality of life of many heart failure patients is being seriously undermined by a **revolving door syndrome** of repeated readmission to hospital. And heart attack or cardiac arrest survivors, people with conditions such as cardiomyopathy, and families affected by sudden cardiac death routinely face the future without access to professional support.

In response, the Irish Heart Foundation has developed **a pathway** of practical, social and emotional support services that begins almost literally at the hospital gates and continues for as long as we're needed.

Around a third of all stroke survivors returning home from hospital are being referred to these services, which also support thousands of heart patients annually.

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Navigating the healthcare system after stroke is extremely challenging and overwhelming but with the resources and support provided by the Irish Heart Foundation I have the information and confidence I need to advocate for myself and the care that I deserve.

Patients describe our services as their lifeline. They reduce the need for admission to hospitals and nursing homes. A heart disease diagnosis or stroke often leads to post traumatic stress disorder. But the counselling we provide is the only

psychological support available to many patients.

Our services are endorsed by the HSE. **But only a fraction of our work is State-funded. Unless this changes, we cannot guarantee continued delivery of our services.**


