Where is Bizzy?

Overview

In these activities (presentation and/or worksheet), pupils will have the opportunity to become familiar with and recognise different prepositions. The Bizzy Breaks heart mascot (Bizzy) is shown in different positions in relation to other objects.

Learning Outcomes

Through the presentation, pupils will demonstrate active listening and joint attention, as well as showing understanding of new words. Through the worksheet pupils will use new vocabulary, recognise words from pictures and use the number of letters in the word to deduce its spelling.

Teaching Notes:

A Powerpoint presentation of Bizzy in different places is available in addition to the worksheets below. Display this on the whiteboard as a group activity. For each preposition, a picture of Bizzy and the question "Where is Bizzy?" is displayed on one slide and the same picture with the answer on the next. Ask the class "Where is Bizzy?" and invite guesses from pupils before moving to the slide with the answer.

The worksheets below include many of the same images and prepositions from the presentation and can be used after the presentation, or on their own.

Differentiation:

There are two workhseets, one with prepositions of place and one of direction. Pupils could choose to complete one or both, or complete the activity in pairs or groups.

The worksheets could also be given to pupils before the presentation to help the pupils to guess the word based on the number of letters.
